- Thomas Gladman came from England in 1692 in the entourage of Sir Thomas Lawrence (came from Chelsea Middlesex Baronet (Prot) to be a county clerk (Royal Secretary) from Chelsea England. and was turned down. I've found no other record.
- From a list of German, Swiss Other Immigrants 1742 - ? Gladman was a commander of the New Catherine, which brought in a load 28 Mry 1742, Fron "Okely, a pedigree and family history " a Thomas Gladman Captain sailed the "Snow Captain from London 15 Mar 1742 to 7 Jun 1742 Philadelphia
- Rebecca Arundel Co. Maryland
 - Mrs. Gladman late of Annapolis Dec John Heresby Exec. 12 Sep 1765 (Newspaper).
 - She was executor for Arthur Toole 1759 and was living with Gov. Horatio Sharpe.
 - She was referred to sometimes as Mrs. but I wonder if that was her age as she clearly was Michael's sister and I found no evidence she married.

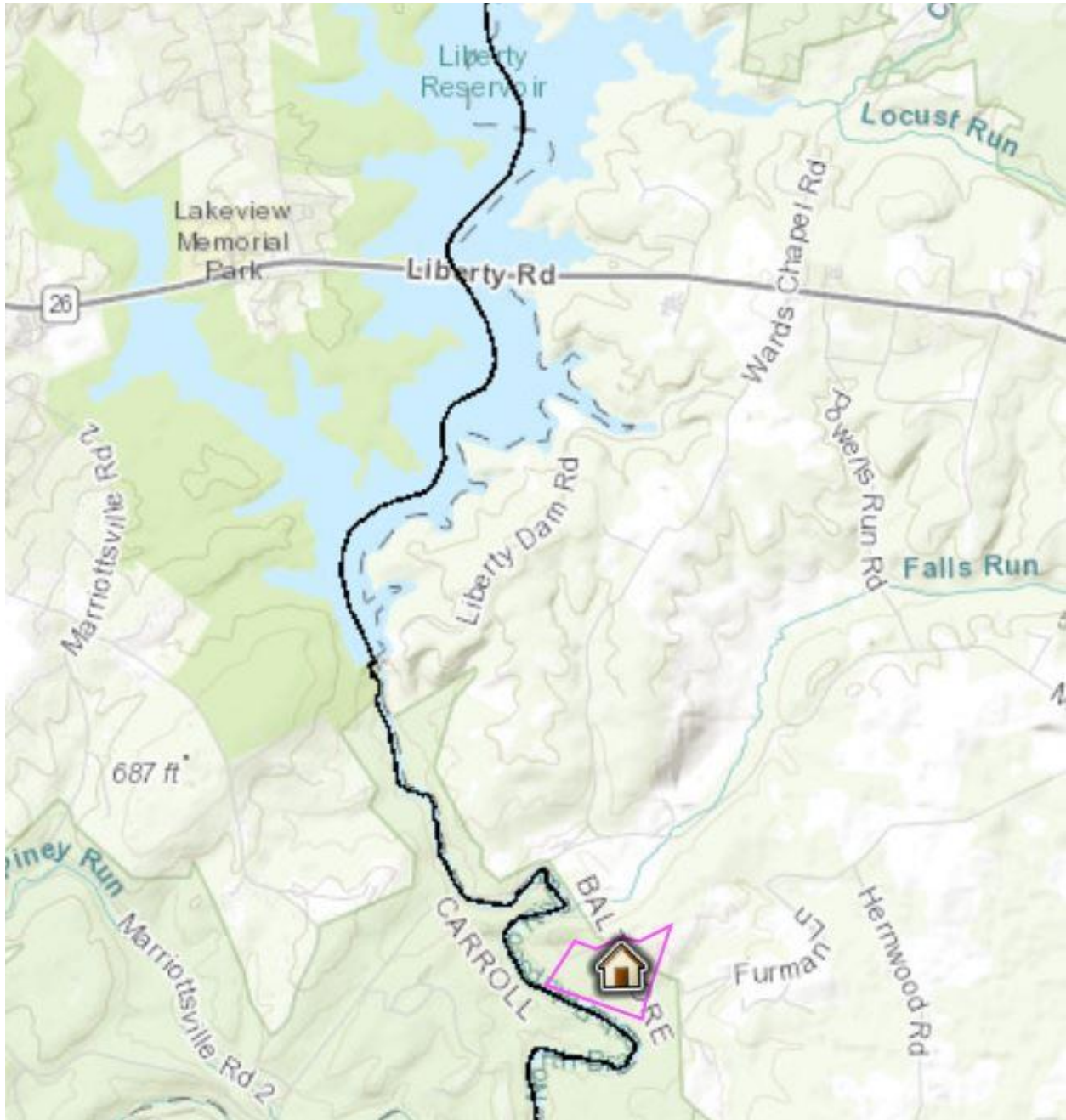

Comments

- Thomas apparently had no wife or children as his will lists Rachel, brothers John and Michael, and nieces and nephews Michel son of John, William Mattocks Jr son of Rebecca, father Michael Gladman

- Michael's will was signed 21 May 1782 and probated 1789. He served in the military on 22 Jul 1776 enlisted by Richard Talbott.
- The family of Michael Sr is well defined by documents so it is assumed the other Gladman;s are descended from John.
- My guess is that Rachel Gladman who married Elisha Stockstill is a daughter of John. The Rachel Gladman b. 1744 is I believe too old. John had a large female population in his household in 1783. We also have wills from Thomas that make it clear he had no children and Michaels's will identifying his children. The babtism records identify Michael Sr's children plus their are no land records for a Gladman who might be Rachel's father.

Property

- Michael Sr bought Patent for "Harkel Pool" and Michael Jr added to it with Patent for "Stockten addition" He also added "Gilcrest Discovery. The **1798 Property Assessment** described the buuildings a hewed log dwelling 1 and 1/2 story 22x11 with an log stable 1 story 20x18 This land passed to Michael Jr's son Thomas Sr and Thomas Sr to his son Thonas Jr
