This very familiar lyric, voiced by the young scamp, Peter Pan, captures the fantasy mood which will invade the hearts of all who see the musical comedy soon to be presented by the Grand Blanc High school drama department.

The drama department, since its inception as a part of the academic curriculum in 1963, has a record of outstanding successes. The plays done under its auspices have been difficult and challenging and have each enjoyed their full measure of success. With this production of the musical, Peter Pan, Grand Blanc High school joins the ranks of the elite and

very daring. We know of no other high school in the state that has ever attempted this production.

The technical problems alone seemed almost insurmountable. Flying rigs had to be designed, installed and thoroughly tested. Flying alone was a very tricky business both for the actor on the wire and the crewman on the rope.

To stay within the realm of make-believe the scenery was designed to carry through the story-book image each of us may have of Neverland. A polka-dot mushroom set amongst dancing trees and a pink and blue pirate ship do much toward this end. The costumes were also designed with this in mind.

Because of this imaginative approach, most of the scenery and costumes had to be made and constructed from the ground up. Students have spent an untold number of hours working to have it all in readiness for opening night.

The music department has, of course, played a very major part in the production. The members of the stage band plus three professional string musicians will herald the entrance of Peter Pan. The musical score is the same as was used originally on Broadway and is not an easy one to master. Many rehearsal hours have been spent here.

In addition, the prop, lighting, sound and publicity crews have been literally working day and night.

It will all culminate next Wednesday evening at eight o'clock when the stage of the Howard Pepper Auditorium comes alive with all the magic and imaginative delight only this particular story has to offer.

The play will run Wednesday through Saturday evening, Feb. 10-13. In addition, a matinee performance will be given at 2 p.m. on Saturday.
