Item all the rest of my personal Estate of what kind soever as well Negroes, as Cattle, hogs, horses and all my household furniture and the crops at my death, then made or making, to him and his heirs forever (no name shown). And lastly my desire is that my just Debts be paid and discharged and my funeral expences by my said in James Conner who I appoint my whole & sole Exr. of this my last Will and Testament ..
